

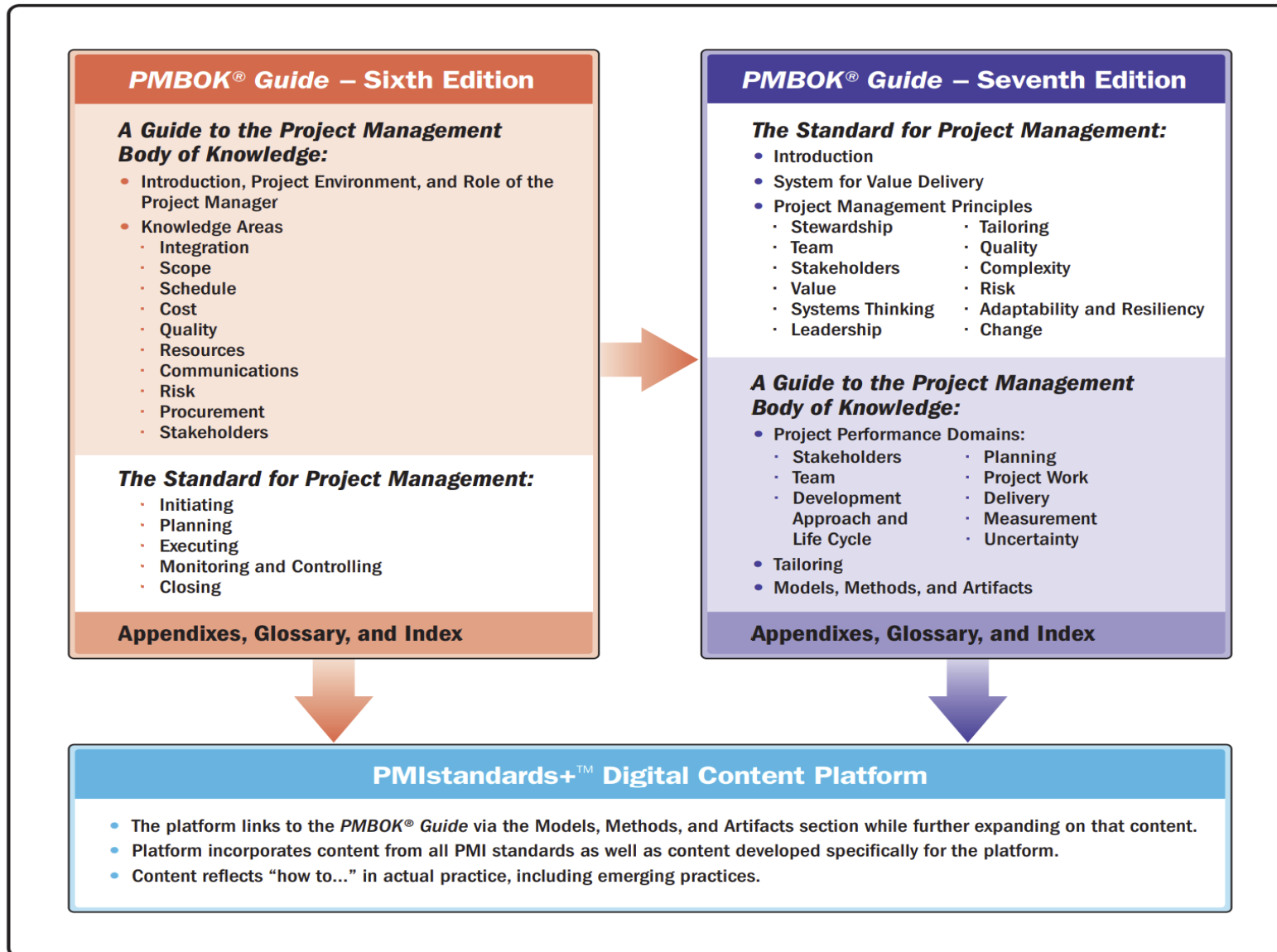
- **PMBOK Sixth edition is Process based guide and the spine of it are the Knowledge areas and Process Groups.**
- **PMBOK Seventh edition moved from Process based standard to Principle Based Standards and you don't see the process and Knowledge Areas.**
- **The Process based approach has been there from 1987 (PMBOK first edition onwards to the Sixth edition 2017 -2020)**
- **PMBOK Seventh Edition emphasis more on Value.**

- New Guide usually replace the previous one. The PMBOK sixth edition is not obsolete, it has been moved to PMI Standards Plus portal for process-based projects.
- PMBOK Seventh edition is adding-on PMBOK Sixth edition
- Knowledge Areas are replaced by Performance Domains (you will look at things from Performance Domain perspective rather than Knowledge Area).

- The PMBOK Seventh edition has **Eight Performance Domains** and **Twelve Principles**

- Seventh edition has two sections, and each section has three lessons.
 1. The Standards for Project Management (ANSI norms that covers all the 12 principles)
 2. A Guide to Project the Project Management Body of Knowledge.
(The eight performance domains have been explained as part this section).
