



- PMBOK Sixth edition is Process based guide and the spine of it are the Knowledge areas and Process Groups.
- PMBOK Seventh edition moved from Process based standard to Principle Based Standards and you don't see the process and Knowledge Areas.
- The Process based approach has been there from 1987 (PMBOK first edition onwards to the Sixth edition 2017 -2020)

PMBOK Seventh Edition emphasis more on Value.





- New Guide usually replace the previous one. The PMBOK sixth edition is not obsolete, it has been moved to PMI Standards Plus portal for process-based projects.
- PMBOK Seventh edition is adding-on PMBOK Sixth edition
- Knowledge Areas are replaced by Performance Domains (you will look at things from Performance Domain perspective rather than Knowledge Area).






The PMBOK Seventh edition has Eight Performance Domains and Twelve Principles
